





Powers to Tackle Anti-Social Behaviour

Vehicle Nuisance

-  The local authority has powers to stop the inappropriate use of vehicles within a residential area.
-  Vehicle confiscation, ASBOs, injunctions and/or prosecution can be used where there is persistent dangerous and anti-social driving.
-  Fines can be issued for nuisance parking on a street where this is caused by the sale and repair of a number of vehicles for profit.
-  Mini-motorbikes can be seized and crushed when these are unlicensed, uninsured or driven in a reckless manner.
